Like a sheep, I have gone astray; I have turned to my own way; and the Lord has laid on him my iniquity. (Isaiah 53:5-6)

Monday: He will again have compassion on me; he will tread my iniquities of \_\_\_\_\_ under foot. You will cast all my sins into the depths of the sea. (Micah 7:19)

Tuesday: Blessed am I, whose lawless deeds of \_\_\_\_ are forgiven, and my sins are covered; blessed am I against whom the Lord will not count my sin. (Romans 4:7-8)



**Wednesday:** There is therefore now no condemnation for \_\_\_\_\_ for me, as one who is in Christ Jesus. (Romans 8:1)

Thursday: And I, who was dead in my trespasses of \_\_\_\_\_ and the uncircumcision of my flesh, God made alive together with Christ, having forgiven me all my trespasses, by canceling the record of debt that stood against me with its legal demands. This he set aside, nailing it to the cross. (Colossians 2:13-14)

Friday: As far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove my transgressions of \_\_\_\_\_ from me. (Psalm 103:12)

Saturday: Though my sins of \_\_\_\_\_\_are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they shall become like wool. (Isaiah 1:18)
