Monday: He will again have compassion on me; he will tread my iniquities of _____ under foot. You will cast all my sins into the depths of the sea. (Micah 7:19)

Tuesday: Blessed am I, whose lawless deeds of _____ are forgiven, and my sins are covered; blessed am I against whom the Lord will not count my sin. (Romans 4:7-8)



Wednesday: There is therefore now no condemnation for _____ for me, as one who is in Christ Jesus. (Romans 8:1)



Thursday: And I, who was dead in my trespasses of _____ and the uncircumcision of my flesh, God made alive together with Christ, having forgiven me all my trespasses, by canceling the record of debt that stood against me with its legal demands. This he set aside, nailing it to the cross. (Colossians 2:13-14)
